Mandatory Training

TIP training typically begins the week after school is out for the summer. If the school district shifts their schedule by adding make-up days then TIP training shifts to the next week. **This training is MANDATORY for all TIP applicants whether new or returning.**

Weekly Workshops

Heritage skills workshops are held every Wednesday morning during the TIP program. Some popular examples of past workshops have been blacksmithing, spinning, leatherwork, pine needle basketry, campfire cooking, and 1900s herbal medicine.

Volunteer Shifts in Costume

Participants will also schedule a weekly 3 hour volunteer shift with the TIP coordinator. Summer is a busy time of year for family vacations, summer jobs, and camp opportunities so the program allows for 3 excused absences. Just be aware of the fact that the program is designed to meet school credit volunteer hours. You will need be proactive about scheduling make-up opportunities.

School Credit Opportunity
