

Couch Historian Ep. 4 Introduction to Census Records

Answer Key

1) What was the occupation of Amy Martin (born in Michigan in 1882) in the 1920 US Census?

Did you find she was a public school teacher in Salem, Oregon? Amy Martin is a really common name. We gave you a few clues to enter into the search perameters. When we just searched for Amy Martin, we got over 10,000 hits. When we searched for Amy Martin born in Michigan we got 354 hits. But, when we searched for Amy Martin, born in Michigan in 1882, we got 25 hits, and really only one good one, with a clear name of Amy Martin. Knowing we are looking at Mid-Willamette Valley history, and the person living in Salem is likely to be the one we are interested in also helps. Any details you know about the person's life can help narrow down your search.

2) What were the names of the children of Utaro & Tora Yoshikai who lived in Marion County in the 1930s and early 1940s?

Yoshie Yuriko/Lillie Tom Henry

How did you get there? Did you search the 1930 Census for the last name Yoshikai and the residence of Marion, Oregon? Did you search for Utaro Yoshikai in the 1940 Census in Oregon? Any way you get there, you hopefully found the children listed. It is interesting to note that Yuriko/Lillie went by two different names in the 1930 vs. 1940 Census. While we might have guessed by looking at the birth order and ages that Yuriko was Lillie, we also know from an oral history interview with her brother Henry that she went by both names.

3) How many people born in China were living in Salem, Oregon in 1870?

According to census records 25. How did we find that number? In the 1870 Census search, we entered the word "China" in the "birthplace" field. We then clicked on the link to "Residence" and entered "Salem, Marion, Oregon" in this field. This brought up 26 results. The last listed individual actually was residing in Jefferson, Oregon, so we eliminated him from the list. This is not a precise count, we can't be sure that everyone was counted in the census, but it does give us a good number to go off of. When looking at the records of individuals, what can you tell about the types of work Chinese-Americans were doing in Salem at the time?


